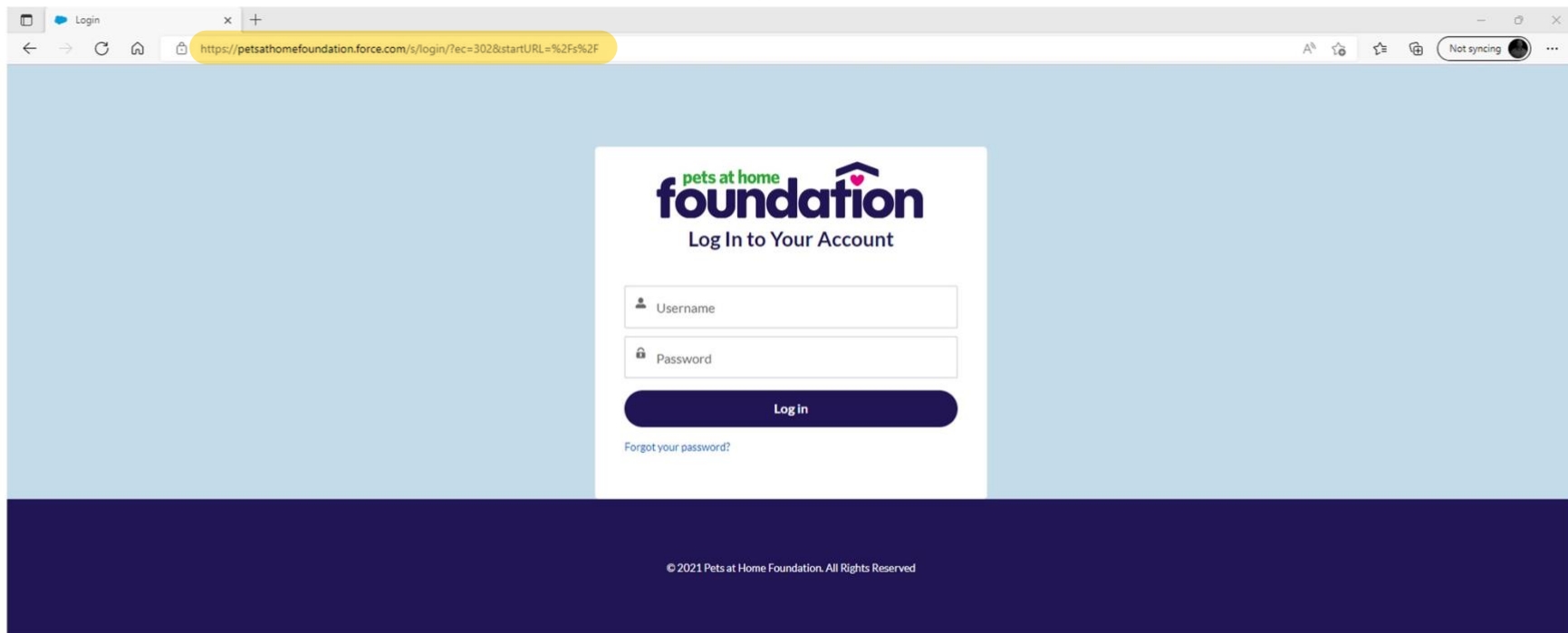




With Santa Paws due to start on 21st November, there will be an expectation for you to log all fundraising done in store. This will no longer be done by paper in store awareness forms and will need to be logged via the Pets At Home Foundation Portal. All money raised or collected must be banked through the till in store. Below is a visual guide how to log everytime you have been in store. If you do not have a log in and password for doing this, it is extremely important you make us aware of this so we can get this reset for you.

1. Log into the Portal at <https://petsathomefoundation.force.com>
2. When you're in the Portal home screen, click on the My Community Partnership Link at the top of the page
3. Select the store you have been in from the drop down list and click next on the bottom of the page.
4. When the page refreshes, click on the link saying "Click Here to access the In Store Awareness Form"
5. Fill in the form and click submit at the bottom of the page.
